Terms & Conditions

1. Competition

- a. "Unmask the Corrupt" logo contest shall commence on 13th August 2014 and shall end 12th September 2014. ("Contest Period")
- b. A complete submission consists of a logo design inclusive of the words 'Unmask the Corrupt' ("Entry/Entries")
- c. Any entries received beyond the Contest Period will not be considered.
- d. The Malaysian Society for Transparency and Integrity ("Organiser") reserves the right to extend the Contest Period if deemed necessary and any extension will be communicated on a best effort basis.
- e. The organiser reserves the right to modify the contest mechanisms, withdraw or terminate this contest at any time at its sole and absolute discretion without prior notice to any person.

2. Eligibility

- a. The contest is open to students in Malaysia from age 13 to 25 only, residing in Malaysia only ("Eligible Participants").
- b. International students are eligible participants for the contest.

3. Submission Procedures

Eligible participants are <u>not</u> allowed to submit more than one (1) entry. To participate, eligible participants must comply with each of the following:

- a. Eligible Participants shall submit a logo that encapsulates what "Unmask the Corrupt" means to them. All entries must be original works and no part or component thereof is copied from any other work or material.
- b. The logo must consist of an originally designed image, which contains the words "Unmask the Corrupt".
- c. Eligible Participants MUST submit their Full Name, Identity Card Number / Passport Number, valid contact number, email address and consent form with their application. Incomplete entries will not be considered.
- d. Each submission will be tied to one Eligible Participant. In the event that a group works together on a submission, the submission will be entered under the name of a primary participant. The complete details of group member must be provided to the Organiser.
- e. By submitting an entry to the "Unmask the Corrupt" logo Contest, the Eligible Participants must confirm that they are the legal and/or beneficial owner or otherwise have the intellectual property rights to submit such materials, and therefore warrants that they have obtained rights in incorporating copyrighted materials, i.e. graphics, images, design etc. in their logo entry. Each entry and any part therefore shall not at any time infringe or violate any laws or the rights of a third party.
- f. Entries must not have been submitted to any other contests/competitions/festivals before. Participants shall also ensure that the entries do not contain content that are illegal, libellous, offensive, obscene or defamatory.
- g. By entering the Contest, Participants shall agree to appear in videos, photographs, write-ups (the "Material") which may be used in promoting (any form of media) or materials by the Organiser. Participants shall not be entitled to any payment for such use, or for any re-use, of the Material; and acknowledge that all copyright in the Material, including the right to reproduce image shall belong to the Organiser absolutely, and to release and discharge the Organiser from any claims in relation to the Organiser's use of image.

- h. By submitting the entries, the producers and owners of the entries are to grant the Organiser exclusive rights of the copyright to use the entries or material submitted for library, promotional or commercial use globally.
- i. Entries will be judged based on creativity, adherence to content and format guidelines and clarity design elements. Judges' decision is final, conclusive and binding. No further appeal, enquiry and/or correspondence will be entertained.

4. Format of the logo submission

Every entry submission should consist the following:

- a. Logo design for the campaign, which includes the words "Unmask the Corrupt"
- b. Submitted as a .pdf and .ai. No larger than 2 MB and 3000x3000 pixels.

5. Finalists and Winners

- a. The eligibility to win the Contest is on the condition that Eligible Participants fully comply with the Terms & Conditions of The Malaysian Society for Transparency and Integrity and /or the Contest Procedures stated herein.
- b. Incomplete entries and / or failure to fulfil all or any of the Terms and Conditions and or the Contest Procedures will automatically disqualify the Eligible Participants from the Contest without prior notice
- c. For the "Unmask the Corrupt" logo contest, the top two (2) best submissions will be chosen as the winners. The organiser reserves right to change, vary or amend these Terms & Conditions, the Contest Procedures and / or any other matters related thereto at its absolute discretion and without prior notice.
- d. Winners will be notified via email after the official closing date of the contest or such other date as decided by the Organiser at its absolute discretion. The Organiser reserves the right to delay the timing of the announcement of the winners of the Contest.
- e. The winners are fully responsible for any injuries, damages or claims as a result of or arising from their participation in the Contest, usage of their prize and/or collection of their prize.
- f. The Organiser accepts no responsibility of lost, misdirected, illegible, late, corrupted or altered entries. Entries that do not comply with these Terms & Conditions will be disqualified without prior notice.
- g. The Organisers will announce the winner at http://transparency.org.my and also via email. The Organisers will not notify winners through phone and text messages.
- h. The Organisers will attempt to reach the winner within 3 days of the announcement of the winners, failing which they will select a new winner from the list of eligible participants.
- i. The winning participants will be invited to attend the Organisers official launch of "Unmask the Corrupt" campaign on 2nd September, where they will receive their prize and their logo will be previewed.

6. Prizes

The two prize winners will receive a RM 500 cheque each.

7. Prize Validity

a. Validity of prizes is six (6) months from the expiry of the Contest Period subject to any extension of the Contest Period as decided by the Organizer at its absolute discretion

- b. Notwithstanding the above, the Organiser is entitled to replace the prize with other prize of similar value at any time without any prior notice.
- c. Winner will be informed on the prize collection venue after the announcement. The organiser reserves the right to change the prize collection venue at its sole discretion and will communicate with the winners on the changes on a best effort basis.
- d. Travelling, lodging or any other costs related to the collection of the prize will be fully borne by the winner
- e. The prize cannot be exchanged or sold for cash and are non-transferable to any other person.

8. Materials

a. The Organiser is entitled and the winners irrevocably and unconditionally permit the Organiser to use, publish or feature the winner(s) for publicity and advertising purposes in any publication, website and / or any promotional materials.
